Dear Parent/Guardian:

We are thrilled to have your child register for our Summer Camp 2021. We look forward to this being a safe, exciting, and positive experience for everyone. Please assist us with our efforts in making yourself and your camper familiar with our rules and regulations.

Camp Fees: \$100/city resident or \$125/non-city resident

Participant Ages: 6-10 years old

Camp Location: Youth Canteen, 1620 Middleton Street

Campers will be on-site at the Youth Canteen Monday-Friday, June 14-July 9 from 9:00am-3:00pm. Camp will be closed on Tuesday, July 5. Drop off begins at 9:00am. All children must be picked up by 3:00pm or they may incur a fine or be suspended from camp if they are habitually picked up late. Extended hours can be arranged for an additional \$10 per week.

Please note that our Summer Camp is heavily recreation based, meaning we will be outside multiple times a day. Cool water will be provided for all campers, but we ask all campers to come with their own water bottle each day. We will take the proper precautions during our hot summer days to ensure the safety of all campers. Closed-toed shoes must be worn every day. Failure to do so will result in sitting out of most activities.

While indoors, all participants will be asked to wear a mask. Campers are responsible for bringing their own face coverings. All camp staff will be masked while indoors as well.

Orientation is Thursday, June 10, at 6:00pm at the new City Gym, 410 Broughton Street. Social distancing will be enforced, and we ask that all in attendance wear a mask. Our camp staff looks forward to meeting our 2021 campers. More information will be provided to you at Orientation.

Please sign and return our RULES & REGULATIONS FORM, SUMMER CAMP REGISTRATION FORM, and PERMISSION TO RELEASE CAMPER FORM along with your non-refundable camp fee to the Parks and Recreation Department, 367 Green Street. Our office is open Monday-Friday, 8am-5pm. Registration is accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Registration begins Monday, June 24, 2021. Spots are limited due to COVID-19.

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SUMMER CAMP RULES & REGULATIONS

1. No one may leave camp without written permission.
2. Parents **MUST** sign children **IN and OUT DAILY**.
3. Drop-off begins at 9:00am. Children **MUST** be picked up no later than **3:00pm** each day. Failure to do so may lead to disciplinary action including expulsion. If additional hours are needed, arrangements should be made in advance for an additional \$10 per week.
4. Flip flops **ARE NOT** allowed at Camp. This is a safety measure, and this rule will be enforced. Only closed-toed shoes (such as sneakers or flats) will be allowed.
5. A Participant Release Form those allowed to pick up your camper is required to be signed and returned with the registration form.
6. Campers must stay in assigned areas with their assigned counselor.
7. Campers will show courtesy to fellow campers and leaders.
8. Campers will respect all city property.
9. Cussing, name calling, fighting, shoving, rough-housing, etc. will **NOT** be tolerated.
10. Equipment will not be abused.
11. Guests of registered campers are not allowed at camp.
12. Campers must always obey leaders and rules. Flagrant disrespect will not be tolerated.
13. Campers must clean their area before going to the next activity.
14. Campers must keep hands, feet, and objects to themselves.
15. Campers are asked to wear a face covering/mask while indoors.
16. Campers must bring their own lunch with them daily. Lunch and snacks will not be provided to campers.
17. We have a **NO REFUND POLICY** for camp fees.
18. We do not provide one on one care to any individual camper.

FAILURE TO OBEY THE RULES AS STATED ABOVE MAY RESULT IN:

1. Verbal reprimand by counselor.
2. Time out from activity.
3. Verbal reprimand by camp director and note to parent/guardian.
4. Phone call to parent/guardian.
5. Suspension from camp for a specified length of time. (Campers suspended from camp will not receive a refund for camp.)

Due to the nature of the offence, Orangeburg Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to implement any of the above steps as necessary.

The City of Orangeburg will not provide transportation for regular season or post-season participation by the registrant.

I understand that photographs of my child may be used for publicity purposes by the City of Orangeburg Parks & Recreation Department.

The City of Orangeburg does not offer a voluntary insurance policy for participants.

The P&R Dept. reserves the right to alter the advertised league/program age groupings if registration in a particular age group is insufficient to form a league.

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ASSUMPTION OF RISK / WAIVER OF LIABILITY / INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

In consideration of being allowed to participate on behalf of City of Orangeburg Parks and Recreation Department athletic program and related events and activities, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates, and agrees that:

1. Participation includes possible exposure to and illness from infectious diseases including but not limited to MRSA, influenza, and COVID-19. While particular rules and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious illness and death does exist; and,
2. I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or others, and assume full responsibility for my participation; and,
3. I willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for participation as regards protection against infectious diseases. If, however, I observe and any unusual or significant hazard during my presence or participation, I will remove myself from participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest official immediately; and,
4. I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS the City of Orangeburg, their officers, officials, agents, and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event ("RELEASEES"), WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL ILLNESS, DISABILITY, DEATH, or loss or damage to person or property, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
